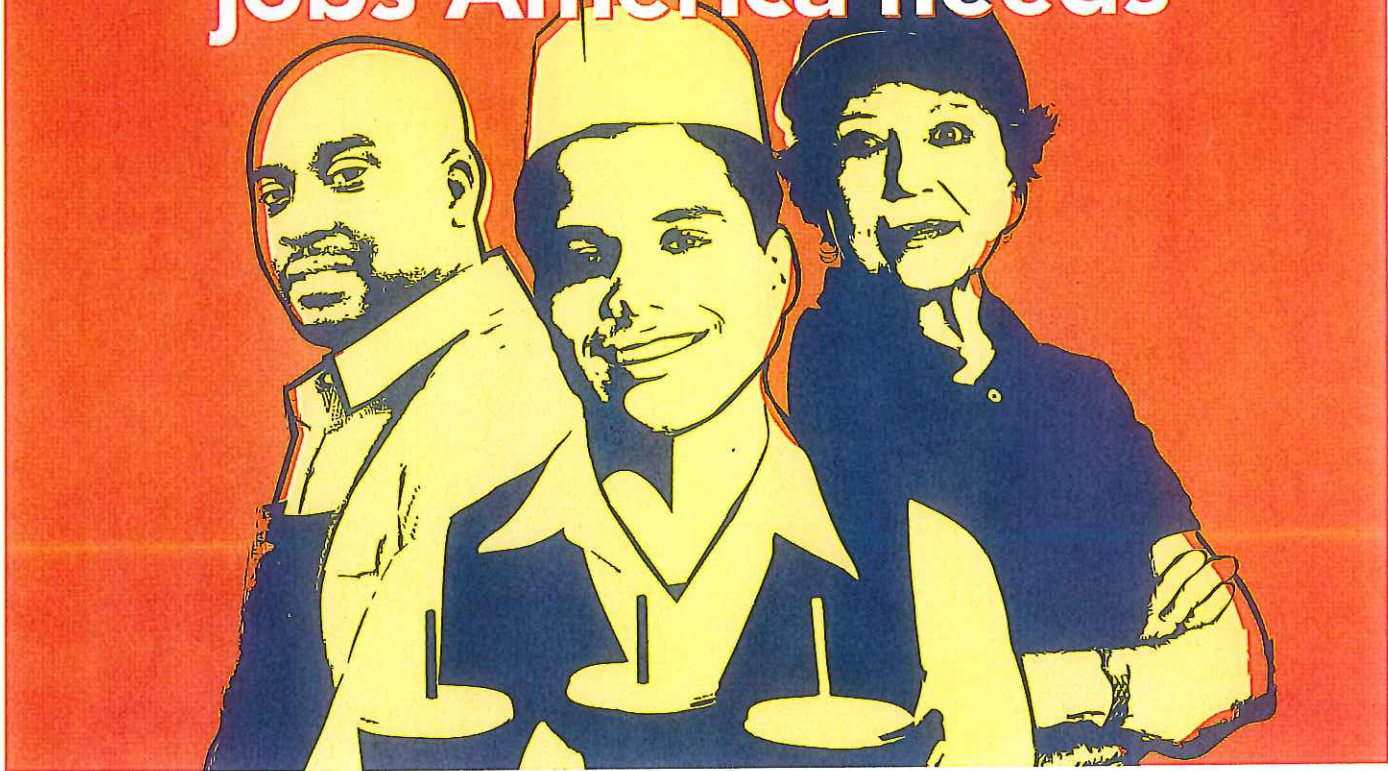


We're fighting for the good jobs America needs
